Re-Registration Course

Overview

The PRINCE2® Re-registration for Practitioners training course adheres to the APM Group syllabus for delegates needing to re-register themselves as PRINCE2® qualified Registered Practitioners. The re-registration course has been tailored specifically for registered PRINCE2® Practitioners who are due to take the PRINCE2® re-registration examination which is required every 3 to 5 years.

Designed For

The 2 Day PRINCE2® Re-Registration course is designed for anyone who has already taken and passed the Practitioner Exam and wishes to receive advice and guidance in preparation for taking the APM Group Re-Registration Exam. The event is not suitable for anyone wishing to learn or substantially revise the PRINCE2® Method. The expectation is that all delegates attending will already have reached the standard of knowledge required, and have succeeded in passing the pre-requisite Practitioner Examination previously.

Benefits

Following the event, candidates will have had an opportunity to:

- Refresh their knowledge of the method.
- Discuss different approaches with Event Manager and colleagues.
- Practice practitioner style questions & receive feedback on them.

Approach

For this 2-day re-registration exam event delegates effectively undertake the 2 Day Practitioner Course, however some Foundation level fundamentals are reviewed. The event is a practical workshop focussing on refresher sessions, discussions and various exercises based on different styles of sample Practitioner Objective Test Questions. The Re-Registration examination is taken at 3.00 pm on the second day and the exam papers are sent to APM Group for marking. Results usually take approximately 2 - 3 weeks.
